The Ile Seguin (historic island in the midst of Paris of 11.5 ha) has been devised as a future international innovation hub dedicated to culture and the creative economy.

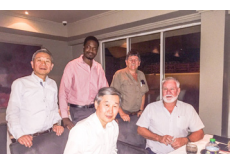
