Our results for 2016 shall be officially announced during our next General Assembly in May. With a turnover of 207 M€ and an international share around 22%, this has been a good year in terms of consolidation of our major subsidiaries abroad. Our order book is stable with 19 months of activity and our portfolio of major works well spread between France (Grand Paris developments, Cigeo project), Europe (International Airport of Geneva, Bar Boljare Motorway in Montenegro) and "Grand International" Projects such as Lima Metro in Peru or Padma Bridge in Bangladesh.

Ingerop Group, active in more than 80 countries, organized a Photo Competition for its 1,700 employees. This first edition took place from 26 September to 17 November 2016.

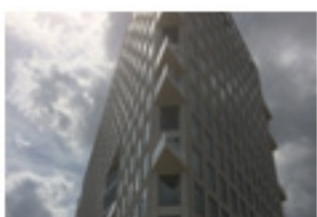
